located in the downtown park between Grand Avenue and Hill Street. Songs such as "Lean

and lyric sheets will be provided.

over the city to share in the joy of singing as part of a large group," said Los Angeles Master

already know, or that are easy to learn, and encourage people of all abilities to be part of

As a prelude to the musical activities, four of the city's most popular food trucks will also be

will be provided to participants, courtesy of Coca Cola. No choir experience is required to

participate.
